

**2004-2007 Medical Veritas and Medical-legal Cases:
Summary of Events related to reports published by Mohammed A. Al-Bayati**

In the last four years, M. A. Al-Bayati published 18 articles in *Medical Veritas* and 16 of them have been used in legal settings.

1) Used in the appeal process in several cases of falsely accused caretakers of injuring and killing children to get a new hearing. These cases include:

- Alan Yurko in Florida [released from prison in 2004]. In addition, to the appeal, M.A. Al-Bayati discussed his case in deposition.
- Cathy Bucher's case [released from prison in 2006]
- Brian Herlihy in Florida [M. A. Al-Bayati recently learned that the court granted him a new hearing.]
- Bryant Arroyo in Pennsylvania [his appeal is filed and M.A. Al-Bayati learned that a lawyer read my report, got interested in his case, and has offered to represent him to win a new hearing]
- Ezbjörn Hahne's case in Sweden: M. A. Al-Bayati's report in his case was submitted to the court [It is hoped that the court will hear his case in future].

2) Reports presented as evidence in court to prevent the conviction of innocent parents accused of injuring children by so called Shaken Baby Syndrome (SBS).

- For example: Patrick Gorman's case in Jacksonville NC [Charges were dismissed against the parents on February 15, 2007].
- Alejandro Mendez's case in Pennsylvania: He was accused of killing his baby Lucas and arrested but he was released in 2005 without trial. [Publishing a report in his case in *Medical Veritas* and other news media played an important role in the positive outcome of this case].
- M. A. Al-Bayat also discussed several articles published in *Medical Veritas* in the court in San Diego, CA in May of 2006, in a case of falsely accused parents of injuring their baby with SBS. This case is not published. [Presenting the articles and my testimony in court produced a positive result in this case].

3) Preventing the government from falsely accusing parents with negligent:

- Publishing three reports on Eliza Jane's case has played an important role in explaining Eliza Jane's case to people, media, and to the DA in Los Angeles. The DA did not file charge of negligence against Christine and her husband in the association of their daughter death because they know that Eliza Jane died as a result of adverse reactions to antibiotic.

4) Alerting people about cases of medical and legal injustice.

- The two reports published on Destiny Jacobo's case helped people to understand her case. Christine and other people are working to help Destiny's mother to file an appeal.

5) Exposing the problem with the adverse reactions to vaccines in children and adults.

- M. A. Al-Bayati described the adverse reactions to vaccines in many reports that helped lawyers to understand the problems.
- The report in the case of the USA Air Force Master Sergeant who lost his hair due to the adverse reactions to anthrax vaccine has helped him to win compensation. In addition, it alerted other people about the problem.
- Reports on the adverse reactions to vaccines were discussed in the court in Arizona in July of 2004 in the case of Greyson and Gwyneth.

6) The reports published in *Medical Veritas* have helped to explain differential diagnoses in court.

- In addition to the cases described above, several reports published *Medical Veritas* were presented in a deposition in a relation to a case in Florida of a worker who developed lung

fibrosis due to exposure to chemicals at the workplace. These reports helped to explain differential diagnoses. This case was settled out of court in the favor of the worker [This case was filed in a Federal court in Florida].

7) Many lawyers have read reports by M. A. Al-Bayati published in *Medical Veritas* and posted on the on the web and called M. A. Al-Bayati to discuss the problems with the SBS theory and issues related to the adverse reactions to vaccines and medications.

8) Reports published in *Medical Veritas* have helped people who are falsely accused of injuring and killing children to seek help and to get their cases evaluated using differential diagnoses. In addition to the cases cited above. M. A. Al-Bayati is evaluating the following two cases and is hoping to publish his findings in *Medical Veritas* in the future after getting the approval of all parties involved.

- A case of 27-year-old father who was falsely accused and arrested of killing his two-month-old daughter with shaking in the state of Texas. He is waiting for trial. M. A. Al-Bayati has evaluated the medical evidence in this case and his findings clearly show that he is innocent and his daughter died as a result of bronchopneumonia.
- A case of falsely accused parents of poisoning their 2-month-old-son with methanol in Ontario, Canada. The baby died in this case and the social services removed four children from the parent's house in 2006. M. A. Al-Bayati evaluated the medical evidence in this case and his findings show that the baby died as a result of hormonal and metabolic problems. The methanol detected in the blood in this case resulted from contamination that occurred in the medical examiner's lab.
